SRUC – A TASTE OF YOUR FUTURE EVENT – THURSDAY 15 MARCH

Your son/daughter has expressed an interest in attending the above event as they may be considering undertaking a course or following a career in this field once they leave school. This event will take place on Thursday 15th March between 9.45 pm and 3.00 pm. Pupils will be leaving school at approximately 9.00 am and will return to school in time to catch their bus home at 3.50 pm.

At this event, students will be able to find out more about the campus itself and will also have the opportunity to visit four subject areas of their choice.
