



Social Enterprise Day – Wednesday 12th February

We are pleased to be able to invite all of our cluster pupils for a full day visit on Wednesday 12th February. This day is being delivered by our Business Studies department in partnership with Social Enterprise Academy, local entrepreneurs and senior pupils from our Enterprise elective. P7 pupils will spend the day in workshops, developing ideas to change their local communities, and will participate in a Dragon's Den finale.

We will share a detailed timeline of events with the P7 pupils prior to their arrival in order to explain where to meet, what to expect and how we will support them during the day.

Transport

We would request that parents take responsibility for organising transport to and from Wallace Hall Academy. If this is not possible then please let your primary school know and we will arrange solutions. Pupils who live in Thornhill will be permitted to walk home.

Pupils can arrive any time from 8.30am onwards and will be welcomed at the front gates next to our School Office. The day will end at 3.45pm when you will be able to meet your child at the school gates if you plan to collect them.

What to wear, bring and eat

Pupils should wear their usual school uniform and bring a suitable snack and water to have during morning break times.

Lunchtime will be just before WHA's normal lunch time, giving pupils an opportunity to experience the canteen, where they can buy a meal deal for £2.10 or bring their own packed lunch. Unfortunately we cannot transfer any credit that is already on your child's primary account so please provide money unless you are entitled to a Free School Meal. Free School Meals will be provided for those pupils who normally receive them.

Medical information

During these visits it is vital that <u>all medical equipment should be with your child</u> e.g. epi-pen/inhaler/diabetic testing kit. Please ensure that your child has their specific medical essentials in their school bag for their transition days, and that they are all in date.

Sharing Information

Please contact your primary school **by Tuesday 28th January** if your child will be unable to attend. We still have a record of the information that you shared about your child prior to their visit in October, please contact our school office if you would like to update any of the contact, medical or personal details for your child.

Your child's primary school will also share information prior to the visit regarding specific learning, health and wellbeing information.
