Career Mentoring 2024

Every year senior pupils from Wallace Hall Academy, who are in their final year of school, are given the opportunity to apply to be part of the WHA Career Mentoring Programme, a scheme which matches pupils with a mentor from the wider business community.

The programme is made up of a series of monthly one-to-one sessions with a mentor, which will allow pupils to prepare for higher education, employment, an apprenticeship and life beyond school. The programme runs from June-December each year. Throughout these sessions, pupils will have the opportunity to discuss future plans with their mentor and work on personal statements and CVs. Furthermore, mentors can arrange mock interviews which pupils will find valuable when applying to university or potential employers.
